Parents Backstage

For dancers under the age of 12: A Mom or female guardian MUST be backstage to assist their dancer with changing costumes. The Mom can go out front when their dancer is performing to watch their performance. Only the dancer and mom will be allowed backstage in the enclosed tent. Bring your dancer to the enclosed tent behind the stage at the call time and sign you and your dancer in and please sign out when you leave.

Makeup & hair must be completed upon arrival for Dress Rehearsal & Recital. Costumes and tights are to be brought in a garment bag, please do not wear them there.

ALL DANCERS' HAIR MUST BE WORN IN A LOW BUN FOR DRESS REHEARSAL & RECITAL.

Dress Rehearsal & Recital Makeup

- Liquid foundation or Powder foundation

match to the color of the back of the dancer's hand (If using liquid foundation, follow up with matching powder to get rid of shine.)

- Rose colored blush: example- Cheekers blush by Covergirl #154



- Eyeshadow pallet: example- TruNaked Eyeshadow pallet by Covergirl #815



- Eyeliner: Color: Black
 - A cream eyeliner works best for the Littles
 - 12+ may like liquid eyeliner better

- Mascara: Black Waterproof works best

- Lipstick – example: Covergirl Continuous Color Lipstick #435 - Classic Red



EYE MAKEUP APPLICATION GUIDE

(A) Highlighter –
The lightest shade used in an eye look. It enhances eye features such as the brow bone and inner corner of the eye.

(B) Midtone –
The medium shade used in an eye look. For a day look, this shade is usually neutral.

(C) Accent – The darkest shade used in an eye look. It adds a pop of color and depth to the eye.

Rehearsal Day – Saturday July 18th

9-10:30 Rehearsal - park anywhere in our lot, behind Little Learners and across the street at the old Sundance Grill parking lot.

All other rehearsal parking – **park south of On Pointe**, behind Little Learners Preschool and across the street at the old Sundance Grill parking lot.

Recital Day Sunday July 19th

9-10:30- can park anywhere in our lot, behind Little Learners, across the street at the old Sundance Grill, Advantage Automotive and Jacob's chiropractic parking lots.

All other Recitals: **park south of On Pointe**, behind Little Learners, across the street at the old Sundance Grill, Advantage Automotive (just north of On Pointe) and Jacob's chiropractic (just South of On Pointe) parking lots.
